

Diana (Winston) Hampshire '55

(1937 - 2021)



Diana had a lifetime association with Kambala and a great passion for the school. Her association with Kambala spanned more than 75 years – as a student, KOGU Archives Registrar, two-time President of KOGU and her positions as both member and President of the School Council. Diana was the first woman and first Old Girl to be elected President of Council, a position she held for 10 years (1991 - 2001).

Diana entered Kindergarten in 1944. She finished her distinguished scholastic career by being elected Senior Prefect and Gurney House Captain in 1955. She was also awarded the prestigious Latham Cup for Work, Sport and Conduct.

Diana was also a proud parent and grandmother within the school community. Her two daughters Jennifer Hampshire '95 and Elizabeth (Hampshire) Burnett '86 and her granddaughter Ellie Burnett attended Kambala.

Diana's lifetime service to Kambala was honoured in 2009 in the naming of Kambala's Early Learning Centre, Hampshire House. She nurtured a continuing relationship with the school and showed an absolute commitment and sense of responsibility to all her duties, always representing the school with dignity and graciousness as well as always upholding the Kambala values.

Kambala has been truly enriched by the long standing service and contribution Diana made to the school and to the Kambala Old Girls' Union. Diana passed away on 25 March 2021.
